- The judgment will be made by a professional and not based on the number of likes/engagements that your video gets. The judge's decision is final and cannot be questioned.
- Only one entry per person will be taken. If multiple entries are present the latest will be considered. However, under cases when several entries are found it'll lead to disqualification.
- Plagiarism will lead to disqualification.
- Maximum Upload File Size is 100MB
- All Participants will receive a certificate of participation on their registered email ID

Event Description:

Rules:

- Participants should choose a category between Indian and Western.
- Each participant has a time slot of 2 minutes to perform.
- Participants are allowed to use props of their choice and must be arranged by themselves.
- Vulgarity and obscenity will not be tolerated and can lead to disqualification.
- The judges' decision will be final and binding.
- Tiktok, Smule, Helo, Dubsmash and any other similar app entries are not considered as valid entries.
- Videos should be submitted without any editing and it should be taken in one shot.

Music

Event name: Raag

Event Description:

The recent outbreak of coronavirus, the pandemic and the lockdown has affected all of us. Here's a chance to add a touch of the quarantine life to your favourite hits. The pandemic has witnessed us singing in our kitchens, washrooms, halls and where not! It's about time you 'Raag' and perform the most beloved tracks with a lyrical lockdown twist of your own!

Rules

- · Solo event.
- Participants have to choose a song and perform for the same to best describe their condition during this lockdown. Participants can make necessary changes in the lyrics.
- Maximum Duration: 2 mins
- Genre and style is open and can be in any Indian Language or English.
- Participants can either use Karaoke/Backing Track or have an accompanist but the accompanist's performance won't be evaluated and the same won't earn any merits. Vocals should be recorded live on camera, Low video quality is acceptable but audio quality must be maintained, Try to minimize background noise as much as possible.
- Editing vocals or adding any type of effect to it is strictly prohibited and may lead to disqualification. Use of any others apps like 'Smule', 'Starmaker' etc is strictly prohibited. Editing the video is not recommended as the submission will be judge purely based on the vocal performance and lyrics but if the participant is has an accompanist then both the accompanist and the participant must be seen on the screen
- Judge decision will be final.

Event Description:

Rules

- Only one entry per person will be taken.
- The participants have to upload a video of them painting/sketching their painting/ Sketch.
- Plagiarism leads to disqualification.
- Judge's decision is final.

Event Name: Style Statement

Event Description:

It has probably been months since you stacked away your best outfits due to the lockdown. Well, now it's time to pull them out and put them back on! Kalakruthi presents to you an online fashion competition where participants compete to make a fashion statement with only their outfits, make-up and attitude!

Rules:

- Each participant must recreate the 5 outfits of either the same celebrity, or 5 different celebrities (Indian or Non-Indian)
- The looks need to be shown through videos. All clips must be put together and submitted to us through Google Drive.
- The final video must adhere to the following technical requirements
 - > Total Duration: 1.5 to 3 minutes, Maximum File Size: 100MB, Portrait Orientation, Watermarks (e.g Tik Tok, VivaVideo) must be avoided
 - Lack of camera quality or bad lighting will not lead to a deduction in points. So please make sure you follow social distancing norms responsibly.
 - Clips of each team-mate might consist of either a ramp walk or just poses or a mix of both.
 - The judgment will be made by a professional and not based on the number of likes/engagements that your video gets.
 - > The judge's decision is final and cannot be questioned.
 - Vulgarity will lead to disqualification.

Rules

- The theme of the Short Movie should be around Covid19 or how the same has influenced the lifestyle.
- Participants should claim copyright in each and every scene used in the film.
- Film should be recorded abiding to the social distancing norms.
- Film must strictly be under a minute.
- Extra points will be awarded if it is shot indoors.
- The resolution of the film should be at least 720p.
- Obscenity, vulgarity and adultery must be avoided and will lead to disqualification

Music

Event Name: Survival of the Fittest

Event Description:

From the depths of our sorrows to our happiest days, music has always had its place on those days. 'Survival of the Fittest' is an event that has been designed for those of you who rap or are into beatboxing. Why rap and beatboxing you ask? Because who doesn't jam to their music!

Rules (General)

- Vulgarity/Profanity will lead to disqualification.
- It is a solo event.
- The decision of the judge is final and binding.

Rules (Rap)

- The participant will be given a beat post registration to which the participant must rap.
- The duration of the rap must be of 1 minute, i.e., 16 bars and can be in any language. It must be an original composition.
- The participant's face must be clearly visible and only the participant's voice must be heard.
- Editing videos, adding effects, adlibs or doublers is unacceptable.
- Tampering with the audio file, i.e., changing the tempo or key, will lead to disqualification.

Judgement Criteria (Rap)

- Structure of bars
- · Wordplay, Punchlines and Metaphors Used
- Flow

Rules (Beatboxing)

- The duration of the performance should be for a maximum of 90 seconds.
- No instrument are permitted.
- No recorded tracks.

Judgement Criteria (Beatboxing)

- Musicality
- Technicality
- Originality
